

PY 2024 Notice of Funding Availability FUNDING FOR PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG)

The Greenville County Redevelopment Authority (GCRA) is now accepting applications for funding of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) eligible activities. The GCRA Board has reaffirmed its primary mission of affordable housing and its second emphasis of meeting the needs of the elderly and disabled population with emergency home repair services in Greenville County. Preference will be given to applications for such programs.

The Greenville County Redevelopment Authority (GCRA) receives annual allocations of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds to address community needs in Greenville County, including the cities of Mauldin, Simpsonville, Fountain Inn, Travelers Rest, and Greer. The GCRA requests proposals from providers of targeted programs and projects particularly those that address neighborhood needs; needs of low to moderate income persons, families, or households; or needs of the elderly. Typical projects funded under this request will have a duration of one year.

Application deadline is February 8, 2024, by 5:00 PM for projects beginning July 1, 2024 via OneDrive. Responses received after the 5:00PM deadline will **NOT** be considered. All applicants must use the PY 24-25 application forms. One full **electronic copy** with all required attachments must be submitted to <u>via</u> OneDrive through a link provided upon request.
